Sermon: Devoted to the Lord

- Biblically speaking, the heart is the seat of thoughts, feelings, and actions, all together. Typically we think of the heart in contrast to the head and think of it as the seat of emotions only. Can you think of any examples where your mind, emotions, and/or actions don't all line up perfectly? What would it look like to have singleness of heart in that example?
- David said he would not give to the Lord a sacrifice that cost him nothing.
   What are some ways you have been led to do a costly sacrifice in the past?
   Are there any costs that you are struggling to give right now?
- The Israelites were commanded to devote things to the Lord by totally destroying them. What was the Lord teaching through this practice? How might this practice be relevant to us today?
- So often the issue with our busyness is an issue of ordered loves. The
  things we become involved in are not bad in and of themselves, but they
  start to become a higher priority in our lives than they should be. What are
  some general trends in our culture where you see this happening? How do
  you see this happening in your own life?
- Dr. Jones said that there's a difference between cultural Christianity and Biblical Christianity. Spend some time praying for one another that anywhere there is a division of heart, the Lord would lead you to be Totally Convinced, Thoroughly Committed.
- Pray that you would each be changed by the One who totally devoted Himself for you.
