Sermon: Outsider Knowledge

Date: 1-14-18

- Can you think of any times where there was a sign that you were in the "inside crowd..." and that you belonged? What did it feel like?
- Can you remember any times where you clearly felt that you did not belong somewhere or that you were an outsider? What emotions did that evoke?
- "Without knowledge of God, we're all left with a hole in our lives." What are some ways you think this manifests itself?
- Do you agree with the examples of ways we draw lines between people socially (resumes, transcripts, etc.)? Can you think of any other ways we do this?
- Reflect as a group on the statement that "There's no way to try to justify yourself that doesn't automatically cause you to look down on someone else." Can you see this in your own heart? Are you willing to share ways you realize you've looked down on certain people or certain types of people?
- What does meeting Jesus as an outsider, not an insider, mean for you
 practically? (It may change the way you look at Him; it may change the way
 you look at yourself.) What changes will need to be made in your life?
- Pray as a group for the willingness to follow Jesus on the other side of the line. Is your group or family willing to help with A Night to Shine? Why or why not?
